COVID-19 Wedding Policy Addendum:

Below, please find our policy implemented in response to the COVID-19 virus. This policy was adopted in accordance with diocesan mandates, local and state governmental guidelines, and CDC recommendations.

- The maximum number of people allowed in the space is 75. This number includes the entire bridal party and family members. Invite others to join you at the reception or to watch virtually (please consult with a member of the clergy. Note, a fee will be involved).
- The seating arrangement of the Nave is designed for physical distancing. Ropes used to block off pews may not be moved or changed, except for the first three rows at the front of the Church used to indicate family seating.
- Masks must be worn the entire time while in the church. The only exception is the bride and groom do not have to wear masks. The wearing of masks is in the Diocesan mandates and the CDC recommendations. Wearing masks protects others and makes them feel at peace while worshiping.
- Everyone will enter the church from the front doors (Wright St). All other doors will remain locked. If anyone attending needs handicap access, please direct them to enter through the west transept (courtyard) doors.
- Service length must be no more than 45 minutes.
- During the service, there cannot be congregational singing. Music may include organ, one or two instrumentalists or a soloist. Before finalizing music decisions, the member of the clergy and the director of music must approve it.
- If someone attending the wedding tests positive for COVID within 14 days of the ceremony, please contact the church office or member of the clergy immediately.
